FORMAT: the video must be playable using Windows Media Player (version 9.1) in a Windows XP environment.

PRESENTATION TO BE ON A USB MEMORY STICK IN A WMV FORMAT.

NOTE: Competitors – ensure that you have a backup copy of the presentation. At the contest orientation each competitor will have an opportunity to test their video.

Step 2: At the time of the presentation:

- (a) Introduce themselves and play the video
- (b) After viewing the video each competitor should be prepared to answer questions specific to their video.
